### **Getting to Your Meetings**

Getting around Capitol Hill

- 1. House Office Buildings
  - **Cannon**: Take elevators to the basement. Follow signs to Longworth. At security, turn left for Longworth.
  - Longworth: Use basement elevators. Follow signs to Cannon or Rayburn. For Rayburn, take the escalator to sub-basement.
  - **Rayburn**: Take elevators to sub-basement. Follow signs to Capitol Subway or Longworth. Use escalators up to Longworth basement.
- 2. <u>Senate Office Buildings</u>
  - **Russell**, **Dirksen**, and **Hart** are connected via basement tunnels. Follow clearly marked signs.

- 3. House to Senate / Senate to House
  - Walking outside: Approximately 0.5 miles along 1st Street NE
  - Capitol Subway System:
    - House side: Board at Rayburn Building
    - Senate side: Board at Russell Building
    - Runs every 2–3 minutes on weekdays when Congress is in session
    - Underground tunnels: Available for members of Congress, staff, and escorted visitors; security protocols may vary
- 4. Security
  - Expect to go through security when entering any building or moving between House and Senate sides.
  - Always have photo ID ready.
