Today, over 300 pastors, rabbis, and faith leaders—a diverse, multifaith coalition representing 28 states and numerous denominations—have come to Capitol Hill. We've organized 90 meetings with your colleagues to deliver a unified message: protecting Israel and ensuring the safety of Jewish Americans is a fundamental American priority.

Why It Matters:

As faith leaders across this country, we are concerned about the existential threats facing Israel and the rise of antisemitism. We believe these issues demand moral clarity, bipartisan action, and an unshakable commitment to security and justice.

What We're Asking:

- **Antisemitism:** We urge you to support robust, sustained efforts to investigate and deter all forms of antisemitic activity and actions.
- **Iran:** Any agreement must permanently dismantle Iran's capacity to build nuclear weapons. Temporary pauses are not enough; only complete elimination is acceptable.
- **Terrorism:** Iran's support for terrorist organizations—regionally and globally—must end immediately and permanently.
- **Hostages:** The United States must exert maximum pressure on Hamas and its supporters to release all remaining hostages, immediately and unconditionally.
- **Gaza Security:** We ask for your support of Israel's goal to create a demilitarized Gaza—free from the threat of Hamas.

Our Main Message:

We may come from different faiths and different regions, but our message is unified and unwavering: Safeguarding Israel and standing against antisemitism is not only a Jewish or Christian issue—it is an American imperative.
